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HUMA BHABHA

VW (VeneKlasen/Werner), Berlin 2 May - 28 June 2014

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Huma Bhabha's first solo exhibition in Berlin shows off the results of her prolonged 2013 residency at The American Academy in the German capital. Due to open during Gallery Weekend Berlin, the show at VW demonstrates Bhabha's accumulative approach to her work. From Rauschenberg's combines to George Baselitz, Styrofoam to terracotta: Disparate influences and materials find harmony and dissonance in what Bhabha does. Born in Pakistan in 1962, the artist has exhibited at MOMA/PS1 in 2012 and was part of the Whitney Biennial in 2010. As an extensive solo show, this is a timely overview of recent work and a perfect introduction to the elements that feed her practice.
