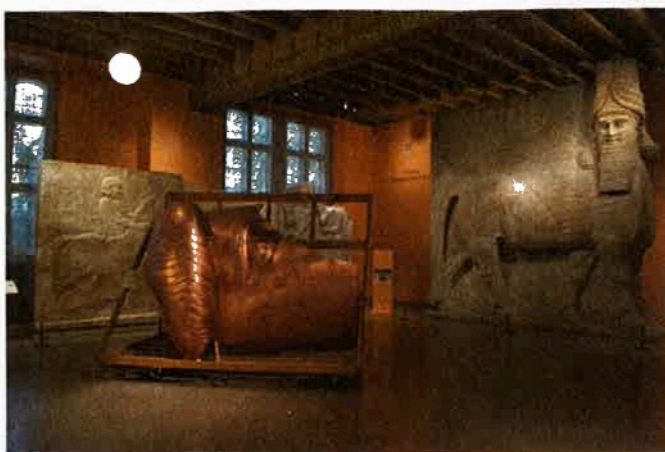




Critics' picks The five best events this week
